Siemens Piezo Injector – Filter Removal & Re-fit



. Undo grub screw on the ASNU 84 Tool

3. Piezo filter location is further inside



4. Re-Fit grub screw using the dimple in the higher position on the pin



- 5. Remove the filter as you would any other injector and inspect it for damage
- 6. Place the new ASNU 219 filter in the top of the injector
- 7. Using a vice with soft jaws and the ASNU 219T tool, gently squeeze together to lock the filter in position. See our video link for this:

Important Tip: If the filter that you remove has broken up, there's a good chance those parts have gone into the injector and may cause blockages & restrictions, resulting in leakage or the injector being stuck open or closed. We would recommend replacing the injector if this is the case.
